Background


- Monrovia began providing transportation services in 1983 with Dial-a-Ride (DAR)
 - At peak popularity, the City owned 9 cutaway shuttles, 13,000 vehicle revenue hours, 130,000 vehicle revenue miles and over 20,000 trips.
 - Beginning in 2015, staff noticed decline in ridership and the price per ride began to increase
 - In 2018, Monrovia ended the small fixed route, made operational changes to the DAR and began public-private partnership with Lyft (GoMonrovia)
 - These changes would help ensure that passengers who needed ADA accessible vehicles were able to have access to them.





Current Hours of Operation

- Lyft is available 24/7/365
- Monrovia Transit
 - Monday-Friday: 7:00am-10:00pm
 - Saturday-Sunday: 8:30am-6:00pm
 - Closed on Major Holidays





Current Cost of Service

Total Costs Since Implementation of GoMonrovia





- FY21-22: \$1.1M
- FY22-23: Projected \$1.2M
- Average Subsidy: \$8-\$9 per rider
 - Monrovia Transit was trending at \$40-\$45 per rider
 - Over 100,000 rides per year





Next Steps

- GoMonrovia 2.0
 - Integrating Monrovia Transit into the Lyft app 24/7/265
 - ADA vehicles guaranteed
 - Study the demand of ADA and senior ridership in the "Late night" hours
 - Received over \$1M in Federal grant funding for this expansion
