



EV Ambassadors Program Progress

Summary

- Sacramento Clean Cities worked with GreenTech to create and oversee the EV Ambassadors program
- Funded by the CMIS grant to support workforce development in Twin Rivers High Schools
- 15 students have been hired, trained and gained work experience through the duration of the program
- All Ambassadors went through an online training designed to educate them on EVs and alternative fuel vehicles. The second cohort of Ambassadors also went through a 10 hour in-person training on EV basics.

Objectives

- Sacramento Clean Cities and Green Tech's objective for EV Ambassadors was to create a workforce development opportunities for Twin Rivers Unified High School students in which they would gain valuable skills to prepare them for their academic and career goals
- An overarching goal of the program is for the Ambassadors to become comfortable speaking in front of a crowd or in conversation and display ample knowledge of electric vehicles and how they can be accessed.

Highlights (November 2025 - Present)

- Hired 9 new Ambassadors from Grant High School through classroom presentations
- Enrolled Ambassadors in in-person training that built on concepts taught in the online curriculum
- Visit to CARB Headquarters, opportunity for Ambassadors to speak about career paths in STEM fields with CARB scientists and engineers
- Acquisition of EV Ambassadors educational and outreach materials
