

## **How to Report Vehicles out of Service for Extended Periods Under the Advanced Clean Fleets Regulation**

If you have vehicle(s) that are out of operation for a long period of time and will not be operated on California public roads you should first place the vehicle on Planned Non-Operation (PNO) with the DMV and email the PNO paperwork to [HDIM@arb.ca.gov](mailto:HDIM@arb.ca.gov).

If the vehicle is ineligible for PNO you may deactivate the vehicle(s) from the account.

**Be aware that deactivated vehicles cannot perform most DMV transactions and until noncompliant vehicles are brought into compliance with Clean Truck Check, it is illegal to operate them on public roads and highways.**

If a deactivated vehicle becomes NON-COMPLIANT during the time it is deactivated the vehicle will need to come into compliance immediately upon reactivation prior to operating on California public roads and/or performing DMV transactions.
